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Potential Effects of Covid-19 on EHS Compliance

- Decrease in Manufacturing Production
- EHS Managers/staff reduced work hours, salary reductions, layoffs, less support staff for EHS tasks
- Spending time on Covid-19 tasks implementing CDC Guidelines
 1. **Wearing Masks**
 2. **Taking/logging temperatures of employees/visitors**
 3. **Ensuring social distancing**
 4. **Monitoring employee travel (out-of-state)**

Potential Effects of Covid-19 on EHS Compliance

- Spending less time on recordkeeping/reporting/monitoring EPS compliance tasks
- Ensuring Certification renewal dates are updated (WWT Operators, TUR certifications, etc.)

Refocusing during Covid-19 on EHS Compliance

- Are you maintaining the required EHS reports/documents?
- Need re-focus on the EHS items that may affect you
- What are those EHS items, when are they due, and is there anything new in the past 6-months?
- Has EPA offered any relief during Covid-19? Does really help?
- DEP has issued extensions for some programs that may help you, what are they?---TURA Planning/reporting = 11/1/2020
