A New Age of Air Permitting: Draft Cumulative Impact Analysis (CIA) Regulations Highlight State's Focus on EJ as a Deciding Factor in Permitting Policy and Facility Operations

In the spring of 2023, Massachusetts will implement new air permitting regulations impacting major and non-major CPAs. The regulations, which are expected to be released for public

comment by the end of 2022, are a game changer and put environmental justice considerations front and center. While the draft regulations impact major and non-major CPA's, we expect these regulations to be a harbinger of things to come in Massachusetts.
